## Earth Skills and Bushcraft Yearlong Immersion Program Details

Below are the tuition rates for our yearlong Earth Skills and Bushcraft Immersion Program. Note that some of the semesters shown at a lower tuition rate are the second semester taken by the student, not necessarily the fall or spring semester. The goal of our tuition structure is to have decreasing tuition costs the more time a student invests in our programs.

\* The cost for the remote summer trip may vary depending on destination and trip length.

\*\* The hunting and fishing camps are optional, and as such aren't included in the total.

There is no time limit for a student to complete their coursework. This means that you can take your first course this year, then wait several years before continuing your coursework and still be eligible for the tuition discounts afforded to yearlong program students.

Students may begin their studies with us during the spring, fall, or winter course, but may not start with the remote summer trip.

While students are encouraged to express their interest in the yearlong program, there isn't a special application process or a financial commitment up-front. Instead, after taking a course and determining that they want to continue their studies, they simply let us know. Yearlong program students will be given priority in course placement.
